BYLAW NO. 1380

A Bylaw to provide for the removal and
disposition of unlawfully parked vehicles

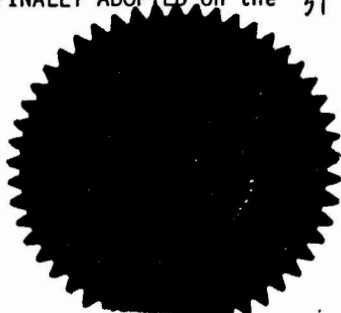
WHEREAS the Motor Vehicle of the Province of British Columbia provides that Council may be Bylaw provide for the removal of any vehicle unlawfully occupying any portion of a highway or public place;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient to do so;


THEREFORE, the CITY COUNCIL of the Corporation of the City of White Rock in open meeting assembled ENACTS as follows:-

1. Any vehicle unlawfully occupying any portion of a highway or public place may upon the order of the City Engineer, a Police Officer or Bylaw Enforcement Officer, be removed to and impounded in such place as is directed by the City Engineer, Police Officer or Bylaw Enforcement Officer and such a vehicle will not be released to its owner until the costs of its removal and impounding is paid to The Corporation of the City of White Rock. If such impounded vehicle is not claimed by its owner within one (1) month of the giving of the notice of the impounding of the vehicle, such vehicle may be sold at Public Auction by The Corporation of the City of White Rock and any monies received on its sale shall be applied firstly, to the costs of the sale; secondly, to the costs of the removal and impoundment of the vehicle; and thirdly, the surplus, if any, shall be sent by registered mail to the registered owner of the vehicle at the address shown for such owner in the records of the Superintendent of Motor Vehicles. Notice shall be given to the owner of every vehicle impounded under this section of the intention to sell such vehicle on the date set out in the notice by mailing the notice by registered mail to the owner at the address for such owner as shown on the records of the Superintendent of Motor Vehicles at the date of impoundment.
2. "White Rock Vehicle Removal Bylaw, 1967, No. 282" is hereby repealed.
3. This Bylaw may be cited as "White Rock Vehicle Removal Bylaw, 1994, No. 1380".
