Did you know?

The City of White Rock has partnered with RES'EAU-WaterNET, a research program funded by Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council's (NSERC) Strategic Partnership Grants for Networks and hosted by the University of British Columbia.

What is NSERC?

NSERC is Canada's federal funding agency that provides funding to large-scale, multidisciplinary research projects in targeted research areas that involve collaboration between academic researchers and Canadian-based organizations.

Who is part of NSERC's network?

The Network involves 18 world-class scientists from 8 universities across Canada and is supported by dozens of public and private partner organizations.

What is RES'EAU-WaterNET's vision for White Rock?

The organization has a vision of meeting clean water demands and protecting the health of small, rural and First Nations communities through collaborative research that produces integrated, game-changing technologies validated by industry and end-users.

Over the next few months, the team will be conducting research from a custom designed mobile research lab to help identify the best technologies and solutions to address the naturally occurring arsenic and manganese in the City's water.
