



Outdoor watering restrictions are in effect every year from June 1 to September 30.

The City supports and promotes sustainable water practices in the protection and conservation of our water resources. Watering restrictions also assists to stabilize water consumption and maintain consistent water pressure during the period of high demand in the months of summer.

Did you know?

One hour of lawn sprinkling uses as much water as 25 toilet flushes, 5 loads of laundry and 5 dishwasher loads combined? Please keep in mind, your lawn only needs approximately one inch of water (about one hour of sprinkling) per week to stay healthy.

STAGE 1 RESTRICTIONS

Stage 1 restrictions are automatically implemented each year on June 1.

Residential lawn sprinkling is permitted:

Morning sprinkling 4:00am-9:00am

Even numbered addresses:

Monday, Wednesday, Saturday

Odd numbered addresses:

Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday

Non-residential lawn sprinkling is permitted:

Morning sprinkling 1:00am-6:00am

Even numbered addresses:

Monday, Wednesday

Odd numbered addresses:

Tuesday, Thursday

In addition, non-residential addresses can also water Friday from 4:00am-9:00am.

These restrictions apply only to lawns; hand watering of gardens, shrubs, trees and flower beds is permitted. When washing a boat or motor vehicle, water hoses must be equipped with an automatic shut off device.

Note: multi-family dwellings are considered even or odd according to the **building number** and not the unit number.

Stage 2 to Stage 4 restrictions are implemented as needed.

STAGE 2 RESTRICTIONS

Residential lawn sprinkling is permitted:

Morning sprinkling 4:00am-9:00am

Even numbered addresses: Wednesday

Odd numbered addresses: Thursday

Non-residential lawn sprinkling is permitted:

Morning sprinkling 1:00am-6:00am Even numbered addresses: Monday

Odd numbered addresses: Tuesday

STAGE 3 RESTRICTIONS

Lawn sprinkling is not permitted.

STAGE 4 RESTRICTIONS

Outdoor water use is not permitted.
