### What to expect this Spring

In February 2016, the City will begin secondary treatment. You may notice differences in the taste and appearance of your water.

The work is necessary to treat the water supply and upgrade critical infrastructure in the White Rock system, and is a part of the City's commitment to implement the Total Water Quality Management (TWQM) Project.

The City will host a Water Quality Open House on March 2, 2016 at the White Rock Community Centre from 5:30 - 7:30 p.m. The City will engage the community on considerations for the long-term treatment of arsenic and manganese that naturally occur in our water system and other water quality concerns.

### **OUR SERVICES**

The TWQM Project will add disinfection, infrastructure renewal, storage capacity upgrades and a modest level of system expansion for future growth.



Monitor water system including 339 fire hydrants, 7 wells and 77.8 km of pipe



Upgraded facilities and added reservoir at Oxford Street. 3D renderings available on City website.



As mandated by Fraser Health Authority, provide secondary disinfection treatment to water



Added remote monitoring and control of water system



Upgrade and seismic updates to Merklin Street reservoir and add pump station facility. The high tower will be removed



Engage community on treatment options for naturally occurring arsenic and manganese in the water. Arsenic levels are close to the limit of Canadian Drinking Water Guidelines
