The City of White Rock has reviewed your request for access to the following records pursuant to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act"):

Any and all documents from January 1, 2009 to the present regarding the construction, maintenance, cleaning, or in any way contemplating:

- 1) the road, roadworks on Vine Avenue, in White Rock B.C.*
- 2) the sidewalk along Vine Avenue, in White Rock B.C.*
- 3) the vehicle ramp access to the Peach Arch Hospital parking lot on Vine Avenue, in White Rock B.C.*
- 4) All water main work that done along Vine Avenue in White Rock B.C.*
- 5) All utilities work that was done along Vine Avenue in White Rock B.C.*

As well as any and all documents regarding any complaints or notice of injuries at the location of Vine Avenue in White Rock B.C.

Note: The request was narrowed down to:

- construction and maintenance records on Vine Avenue, between Best Street to Hospital Street as per the attached map, from January 1, 2009 to present*

Access to these records is available. However, some of the information in the records is excepted from the disclosure requirements of the Act. I have severed the excepted information so that I could disclose to you the remaining information as attached.


The severed information is excepted from disclosure under sections 14, 15(1), 21 and 22 of the Act. Severing is necessary under the following Sections:

- Section 14 legal advice (subject to solicitor client privilege)
- Section 15 information disclosure would be harmful to law enforcement (security of any property or system, including a building)
- Section 21 information would be harmful to business interests of a third party
- Section 22 is necessary to avoid disclosing third-party personal information without permission.

It is also noted there are copyright pages within provided in accordance with the request, which have been included with this response. These pages include drawings released subject to the *Federal Copyright Act* and in accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, and further copies must not be made without permission of the holder of the copyright.
