White Rock City by the Sea

White Rock is a picturesque seaside community of 22,000 residences. This residency is based out of the Landmark Pop-Uptown Gallery in the Uptown area of the City which is bustling with unique local retail business, restaurants, and cultural spaces.

Invitation

The City of White Rock invites an artist or a team/collective of artists to apply for the Artist in Residence program. This program is a 4-week community engagement residency supporting emerging and established artists. The residency aims to foster an appreciation for arts and culture through innovative programming that will engage the community, throughout the month, and specifically during the White Rock South Surrey – Culture Crawl.

Program

The artist(s) may use the gallery as a workspace and programming space. Art may be exhibited that informs and contributes to the art project.

The artist is responsible for:

- Delivering a minimum of 2 unique free programs that run once a week throughout the month and are featured at the October 5 & 6 White Rock, South Surrey Culture Crawl that inform your work.
 - Programming to inform the project/art and may include but is not limited to, art workshops and classes, art demonstrations, lectures, and presentations.
 - o Collaboration with other White Rock cultural community groups is encouraged.
- Keeping the gallery open to the community Thursday through Saturday 10am to 5pm at a minimum.
- Cleaning the gallery space
- Patching and sanding any walls where art was hung.
- Submitting a short report about their work experience describing the impact on you as an artist.

The Space

The residency does not include living space but does include the Landmark Pop-Uptown Gallery with the following specifications.

- Located in a popular shopping area.

- Includes access to a working sink.
- Includes 2 parking spots

- Must be 18 years or older
- Legally able to work in Canada
- Must be able to provide insurance listing the City of White Rock as an additional insurer on the artist's \$2,000,000 liability policy.
