It's that time of year again! 2012 pay parking decals and dog licences will be available for sale beginning Thursday, December 1, 2011. The decal cost will be \$30 plus HST.

To qualify for a pay parking decal you must be a resident of the City of White Rock. Please provide:

- A valid driver's licence with your White Rock address
- Your current valid owner's certificate of insurance (ICBC) and vehicle licence showing the same address as your driver's licence.
