HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE

White Rock City Hall will be closed on Monday, December 26 and Tuesday, December 27, 2011 for Christmas Day and Boxing Day. Recycling, Green Can and garbage collection will be scheduled as follows:

Single-Family Garbage, Recycling and Green Can

Single-family collection normally scheduled for Tuesday, December 27 will take place on Wednesday, December 28. Collection scheduled for the rest of the week remains unchanged.

Multi-Family Dwellings/Commercial (7+ Units with Bin Collection)

Multi-family/commercial Garbage and Recycling and Yard Waste collection normally scheduled for Monday, December 26 will take place on Wednesday, December 28.

Please have all receptacles curbside by 8:00 a.m. on collection day.
