The White Rock Museum & Archives is honoured to be hosting the travelling exhibit, *Chinese Legacies: Building the Canadian Pacific Railway*. Created by the Revelstoke Railway Museum, the exhibit examines the reality of railway building for Chinese labourers during the 1880's. Themes discussed include travelling to Canada, working conditions, discrimination, and life after the railway was complete. Featured in the exhibit are a diorama of campsite, video, photo slide show and an interactive station for children.

In conjunction with the exhibit, the White Rock Museum & Archives is featuring art work created by young artists and members of the White Rock Chinese Arts Centre. Other featured items include historical ceramics, sculptures and textiles.
