Re: Request for Records
Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act

The City of White Rock has processed your request for access to the following records pursuant to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act)*:

- *any and all records including but not limited to communications, surveys, reports, polling, recommendations, analysis related to the issue of Dogs on the White Rock Promenade. The requested records should be searched for in years 2016, 2017 and 2018 and should include among others, the records of CAO Bottrill.*

Information about the recent delegation heard by City Council on December 10, 2018 is available on the City website (see <http://www.whiterockcity.ca/AgendaCenter/ViewFile/Minutes/12102018-647> at page 2). It seems that the only prior engagement with the issue of dogs on the Promenade between 2016 and 2018 appeared in a dog licensing survey conducted in 2017. The Director of Planning and Development Services, Carl Johannsen, has provided the following comments about the dog licensing survey:

- *On December 12, 2016, Council received a report regarding dog-related bylaws and White Rock's fees and licenses compared to other municipalities;*
- *this report identified a City initiative (noted as 'dog survey' in report) to educate dog owners of their responsibilities, and encourage the owners of un-licensed dogs to ensure they are licensed;*
- *a cost of \$13,100 was noted for two canvassers to go door-to-door and conduct this awareness initiative (see page 135 of agenda: <http://www.whiterockcity.ca/AgendaCenter/ViewFile/Agenda/12122016-129?packet=true>);*

- *Staff moved ahead with this dog awareness initiative in fall 2017; in the course of engaging dog owners, canvassers also communicated with dog owners about where dogs are allowed in the City and where they are not;*
- *the cost for the two part-time individuals that undertook this work was approximately \$7,000;*
- *In the initial stage of this initiative, an informal 'dog survey' form was used by canvassers as a tool to 'break the ice' with potential dog owners and obtain data;*
- *Based on collected written and verbal information, staff put together a spreadsheet that tracked the number of dogs per property (including which were licensed and which were not).*
- *One of the questions in the initial survey form asked respondents their view of dogs on the waterfront (ie. Promenade), as a part of helping residents be better aware where dogs are permitted or not;*
- *This question led some to conclude that the City was doing a specific survey to gauge public opinion about dogs on the Promenade;*
- *here is the PAN article that reported on this issue at the time:*

- *the intent of the Promenade question was not to raise expectations about allowing dogs on the Promenade, but rather to engage dog owners on where dogs are allowed and not allowed;*
- *Though well-intentioned, the Promenade question 'missed the mark' and was not used (along with the survey form) for the rest of the awareness initiative, as it didn't fit in with the purpose of this initiative, as described above;*
- *The canvassers instead engaged dog owners through door-to-door distribution of an educational brochure, while still recording licensing information;*
- *A more generic form was also used to record any other information/comments regarding dogs from respondents;*
- *As the initial dog survey questions were abandoned about mid-way through the initiative, data specifically regarding dogs on the Promenade is not recorded on the spreadsheet, as this data is incomplete and won't provide a reliable 'finding' that conclusions can be drawn from (relative to the data re: licensed vs unlicensed dogs), due to these key factors:*
 - *the responses don't represent the total number of property owners/residents that were engaged through the overall dog awareness initiative;*
 - *most of the responses (over 65%) are from owners/residents located west of Johnston Road only; and*
 - *it is anticipated that most of the responses were from persons that own dogs (in many cases where canvassers found that owners/residents did not own dogs, the engagement ended without further questions being asked).*

A copy of the brochure and both survey forms that were used for the 2017 dog licensing survey is attached. I have printed "Form 1" on the initial survey form and "Form 2" on the one that replaced it for ease of reference.

The publicly available information in the completed surveys is summarized here:

Tips and Safety around Dogs

The City of White Rock Animal Control ensures White Rock is a place where pets, their owners and neighbours live in safety and harmony.

Helpful tips to avoid a dog bite:

- Do not pull a dog's tail.
- Do not take away a dog's food, toys or bone.
- Do not encourage aggressiveness by playing tug-of-war: play fetch instead.
- Do not disturb a dog when it is sleeping or eating.
- Always keep your face away from dogs.
- Teach children to pet, rather than hug a dog.
- Never leave children and pets unsupervised. If a dog gets overexcited when children play, place the dog in a kennel or another room.
- Never approach a dog with her puppies.
- Never approach a dog in a vehicle.
- Dogs instinctively protect their family, so do not get between a dog and their owner.
- Never run away from a dog.
- Always let a dog sniff your hand prior to petting it.

Dog Owner Responsibilities:

- Always have your dog on a leash when in public.
- Dogs are not permitted in some areas of the City. Be sure to check for signs.
- Promptly clean up after your dog.
- Always have a responsible person in charge of your dog.

Why do dogs bark?

A dog barking is similar to a person talking; it is their way of communicating. If you own a dog, you have probably noticed that your dog uses different types of barks – a whiney-type when he/she wants something, a deeper bark when someone is at the door or a high-pitched bark when he/she wants to play. These barks are different ways of your dog trying to tell you something.



If you can determine why your dog is barking you can easily address the problem and avoid complaints.

Some common causes of barking include:

- Boredom
- Experiencing unfamiliar noises while outside
- Loneliness

If your dog is vocal, help keep your neighbourhood peaceful with these tips:

- Turn the radio on when leaving your dog alone in the house. This can help combat loneliness.
- Stuff a toy with treats to keep your dog occupied when home alone. They will have to work for their tasty reward!
- Purchase a citronella collar for your dog. This collar is designed to release a spritz of citronella when a dog barks. Dogs typically dislike the smell, and learn not to bark through this gentle training technique.





Dog Licensing in White Rock

All dogs over the age of four months residing in White Rock must have a valid dog licence and a tag with an identification number that remains the same for the duration of the dog's life. A tag no longer needs to be replaced when renewing a dog licence at the beginning of each calendar year. Dog licences are valid from January 1 to December 31 in the year in which it is issued.

Every dog owner must ensure that a valid dog licence tag is displayed on the dog at all times by affixing it to the dog by a collar, harness, or another suitable device.

Did you know?

White Rock dog licences are the same price or lower than other Metro Vancouver municipalities. Fees for licences differ depending on whether the dog is spayed or neutered.

Dog licence renewal forms are mailed in December to owners for dogs on record and are due and payable January 1.

Male or female dog (not neutered or spayed)	\$40.00
Neutered male or spayed female dog	\$25.00*
Replacement of a lost tag	\$10.00

Benefits to Licensing

Why should I license my dog?

- Dog licences function as a cost-effective insurance for the safe return of your dog should he or she become lost. A licence on your dog's collar is the fastest way to contact you and reunite you with your furry loved one.
- A licence is immediately visible to anyone who finds your dog and shows that your dog is not homeless.
- A licence will save you money on possible impounding or boarding fees.
- Dog licences also help fund services such as dog parks or other programs and facilities based on the number of licensed dogs in the City.
- Information about licensed dogs assists in the medical follow up of individuals exposed to a dog bite.

Remember! Dogs must be on a leash at all times in public places and are not permitted on the pier or the promenade.



Off Leash Dog Area

Did you know that White Rock has an off-leash dog area? In October 2012 the City of White Rock officially opened the off leash dog area. The off leash dog area is located in Ruth Johnson Park between the Centennial Arena building and the playground. The large, treed and fenced area is great location for residents and their dogs to enjoy. Those using the off-leash dog area are encouraged to pick up after their pets in order to ensure a clean area for all users.

This initiative is part of some of the steps the City is doing to have a better understanding of how many dogs are actually in White Rock as some dog owners are not aware of the requirements of the Animal Control and Licensing Bylaw. This need for the survey was also discussed in the Corporate Report presented to City Council on December 12, 2016, "[Animal Control and Licensing Bylaw, 2012, No. 1959 Review](#)" (survey, page 136).

As you may know, the City does find stray or lost dogs without any form of identification on them. We have had some successes in reuniting lost dogs with their owners when they have a City of White Rock licensed dog tag. However, as you can appreciate, when a dog is picked up that is licensed and has another form of identification on him or her, our Bylaw Officers are able to reunite them with their owners faster, and decrease the trauma that some dogs experience when they are lost.

Through this survey the City also wants to engage and have a conversation with White Rock residents and see how many people know where their dogs are permitted and where they are not. Another goal of the survey is to get a better feeling from White Rock dog owners on where dogs might want to be allowed in the future and services that may be desired for dogs in the City.

FYI below; I recall that the survey initially involved the surveyors asking homeowners about 'dogs on promenade' (to gauge pro/cons and also note that promenade/pier was off limits to dogs), but that question was dropped midway through the survey period when it became evident that the point of the survey - being a public awareness initiative to encourage dog owners to license their un-licensed dogs and/or renew their existing dog licenses - was being lost in the midst of concerns being raised in the public sphere about potentially allowing dogs on the promenade.

I've attached the survey excel sheet that documents the work of the surveyors. You'll notice the 'dogs on beach' (short for dogs on promenade and pier) column is empty, as this data was omitted due to being an incomplete set (given the collection ended mid-way through the survey period) compared to the remaining columns.

I'll forward a separate email exchange with Sandeep that states my findings of the survey, relative to what is shown in the spreadsheet and how the data was collected.

In my opinion this survey was poorly designed and executed; this being said, while the strength of the initiative was making dog owners aware of licencing requirements, it's probably better just to do a public awareness blitz with mail-outs, social media, press release that doing a door to door survey.
