A. PERMISSION IS HEREBY GRANTED TO: Urban One Construction BC Inc.

to do the following work at the above location:

- (December 2018 June 2019) Perform trucking ingress/egress and street parking closures Monday to Friday 7:30am to 7:00pm and 9:00am to 7:00pm on Saturdays as per TMP DWG 03 date stamped received December 5, 2018. The contractor is to contact Parking Services Department at 604-541-2100 if vehicles are parked in posted no parking areas adjacent to the site. Construction activity is only permitted to occur during Noise Bylaw hours. Two way traffic along Foster Street and Martin Street is to be maintained at all times.
- (December 2018 June 2019) Utilize City property to perform temporary shoring and excavation works as well as erosion and sediment control necessary for the excavation to occur at 1484 Martin Street. Works are to be conducted as per the Shoring Plan submitted by Geopacific and sealed by M. J. Kokan, P. Eng and date stamped received December 5, 2018, and Sediment Control Plan submitted by WSP Canada Inc and sealed by B.C. Rooney, P. Eng and date stamped received December 5, 2018.
- TCPS are to assist pedestrians as required.
- The contractor is to distribute construction notices to adjacent businesses and residents that may be affected by site construction activity. Notices are to be delivered a minimum 72 hours (3 business days) in advance.
- The contractor must notify the Operations Center 604-541-2181 to alert of the road closure a minimum 72 hours in advance. No driveways are permitted

- to be permanently blocked as a result of the closures. Emergency vehicles are to have access if required.
- Trucks are to abide by the City's Truck Route (Street and Traffic Bylaw) as well as approved Truck Routes 1-6.
- Any use, alterations or improvements on the City Boulevard must first be approved by the Engineering Department.
- The owner/contractor is responsible for the repair of any damage to the road and right of way as a result of the works.
- The applicant will submit a deposit of \$50,000.00 to the City of White Rock as a
 security to be held to guarantee proper placement of fill, removal of shoring,
 protection of utilities and the restoration of the City Right of Way. Deposit is
 refundable upon certification by a Professional Engineer assuring the integrity of
 all underground utilities, and complete restoration of the City Blvd as per
 MMCD and Municipal Standards.
- The applicant's consulting engineer must determine the location of all utilities in the right-of-way to ensure that no utilities will be damaged during the course of construction. Any damage that occurs will be to the sole cost of the owner or the owner's representative.
- An encroachment agreement with adjacent property owners is a private matter between property owners. Issuance of this permit by the City of White Rock's Engineering Department in no way provides approval for encroachment into adjacent properties nor does the City take responsibility for damage to neighboring properties affected by this excavation. Encroachment by this excavation into City property is the extent of the Engineering authority.
- Backfill, excavation, and shoring must be designed and certified by a Professional Engineer. Anchor rods within 1.5m of the surface or within 1.0m of any underground utility are to be removed. Anchor rods not removed must be de-tensioned or fully grouted. Shotcrete, jet grout and or whaler walls placed on City property to be removed to a depth of 1.5m below the surface or if within 1.5m of any utility removed to 1.0m below the utility.
- Owner is to provide certification by a professional engineer that backfilling and shoring requirements have been fulfilled as indicated on the submitted plans an that no damage has been caused to plant, property, or utilities of the City or any utility company.
- The hours of work are to be as per the City of White Rock's Bylaws, policies and regulations.
- Applicant to verify the depth and location of City Services. Data provided by the City is for information and convenience purposes only.
- Adjacent boulevards are to be restored to same or better condition, to the satisfaction of the adjacent home owners and to the satisfaction of the Director of Engineering and Municipal Operations.
- When work is being conducted around protected City trees, the owner's arborist will be required to be on-site to supervise the works to ensure that no protected trees are damaged.
- Safety fence/hoarding to be installed on City property as per the structural engineer's approved design and the geotechnical engineer's recommendation in order to maintain safety for the public.

• The geotechnical engineer must provide weekly monitoring and site inspection reports to the Engineering Department. The geotechnical engineer must install monitoring points and survey these points to identify potential movement. This must occur until all exterior walls have been constructed on site.

B. COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS

 Release of security held as a condition of this permit will be considered upon appropriate submittal of documentation by the owner/developer and their consultant(s), and to the satisfaction of the Director of Engineering and Municipal Operations.



- (December 2018 June 2019) Install temporary crosswalk as per civil plan submitted by WSP Canada Inc and sealed by B.C. Rooney, P. Eng and date stamped received December 5, 2018 and perform single lane alternating road closures as per TMP DWGS 17 and 18 date stamped received December 5, 2018.
- (December 2018 June 2019) Utilize City property for the purpose of installing construction fence, placement of trailers, bins, seacans, and dewatering tanks as per the Foster Martin on White Rock Commons Site Plan date stamped received December 12, 2018. Utilize TMP DWG 03 for the purpose of maintaining temporary curb lane/boulevard loading zones between the hours of 7:00am to 7:00pm Monday to Friday and Saturday 8:30am to 7:00pm. - The contractor is to distribute construction notices to adjacent businesses and residents that may be affected by site construction activity. Notices are to be delivered a minimum 72 hours (3 business days) in advance.
- TCPS are to assist pedestrians as required.
- Trucks are to abide by the City's Truck Route (Street and Traffic Bylaw) and the "Primary Trucking Route" as indicated in the Construction Management Plan for the project as well as approved Truck Routes 1-6.
- The contractor must notify the Operations Center 604-541-2181 to alert of the road closure a minimum 72 hours in advance. No driveways are permitted to be permanently blocked as a result of the closures. Emergency vehicles are to have access if required.
