

Need to register or renew your dog's licence?

All dogs living in White Rock must be licenced. Dog licensing in White Rock is primarily used for insuring dog identification and proof of ownership.

Should your dog ever get lost or stolen, the licence on your dog's collar is the fastest way to contact you to reunite you with your dog.

With Dogs eApply you can:

- Register your dog and pay for a dog.
- Licence or purchase a replacement tag.
- Update information about your pet, including a picture.
- Add additional dogs to your account.
- Receive your dog's annual renewal notice via email.

Dogs can go off-leash in the off-leash dog park located in Ruth Johnson Park.

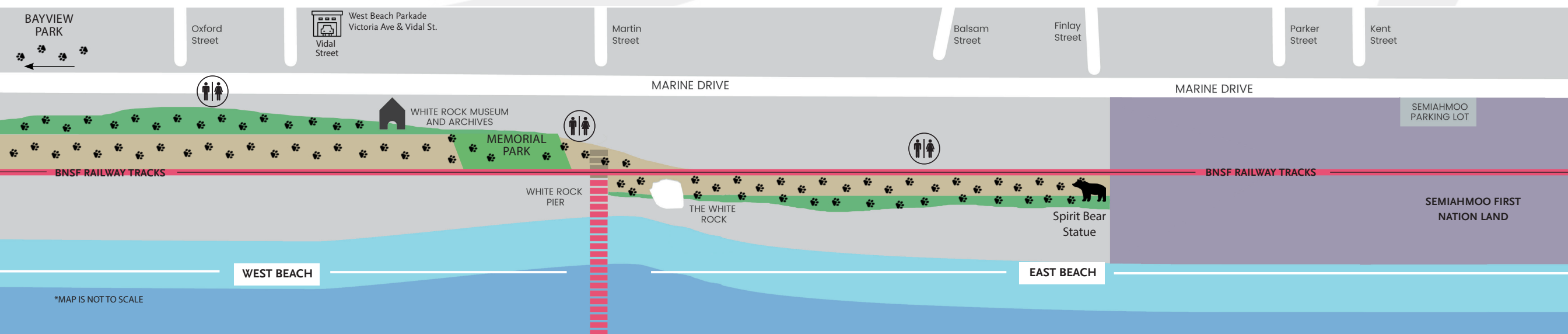


Dogs are allowed on the Promenade from Oct.1, 2019 to March 31, 2020.

Where can I take my dog on White Rock's waterfront?

You can take your dog to Memorial Park and to White Rock's Promenade, as well as on sidewalks on Marine Drive and throughout the city. The Promenade can be reached from Marine Drive.

Does my dog need to be on a leash?

Dogs must be on a leash throughout White Rock, except for Ruth Johnson Park where there is a leash-free area for dogs. On the Promenade, leashes must be two metres or shorter.

Are leashes required for dogs on the beach?

All dogs must be on a leash anywhere near the waterfront. The same rules apply for the beach. The Boundary Bay Wildlife Management Area calls for dogs to be on a leash of two metres or less.

How is the City of White Rock ensuring pet owners pick up after their dogs?

The City of White Rock is providing bags for disposing of dog waste. The bags are to be deposited into the garbage cans on the Promenade or transported home for disposal.

Bylaw officers regularly visit the Promenade and can issue a fine of \$150 to people who don't pick up after their dogs.
