Yellow Bag for Paper Recycling

Material	Description	Not Accepted
	✓ Daily and community newspapers and advertising flyers	✗ No plastic bags used to cover newspapers/flyers ✗ No rubber bands
	✓ All types	
	✓ All types	
	✓ Phone books; directories	✗ No hard cover or paperback books
		✗ No non-paper or foil gift wrap ✗ No ribbons or bows ✗ No musical greeting cards with batteries
	✓ Note pads; loose leaf paper; white or coloured computer, copier and printer paper; printed paper; plain and window envelopes ✓ Shredded paper accepted - do not separate in plastic.	✗ No padded envelopes ✗ No separate plastic bagged shredded paper. Use cereal/shoe box to contain shredded paper
	✓ Shipping boxes, grocery and liquor store boxes Must be flattened and/or cut to fit in yellow paper recycling bag	✗ No cardboard boxes with wax coating, e.g., empty shipping boxes made available for residents to transport their groceries home
	✓ Boxes for cereal, shoes, tissues, frozen entrees, desserts, detergent; carrier trays for bulk bottled water, soft drinks, cans, paper towel and tissue cores/rolls <i>Flatten and place boxboard directly into the recycling collection container, not inside another box.</i>	✗ No paper towels or tissues
	✓ Egg cartons, take-out beverage trays, paper-based garden pots	✗ No residue in garden pots
	✓ Any colour, including brown bags, e.g. grocery sacks, white bags, prescription bags; brown envelopes	✗ No padded envelopes ✗ No foil-lined bags, e.g., packaged cookies
	✓ Multi-layered bags for flour, sugar, etc.	✗ No bags with a foil layer ✗ No paper bags with plastic lining (e.g. tortilla bags)


Blue Box for Container Recycling

Material	Description	Not Accepted
	✓ For food including pet food; tins for cookies, tea, chocolates, etc.; include metal lid <i>Empty and rinse cans. Labels OK. Remove lids, drop into can and squeeze top slightly.</i>	✗ No steel paint cans ✗ No coat hangers, no metal toys ✗ No pots, pans and baking trays ✗ No appliances ✗ No metal hardware or scrap metal ✗ No wiring, metal cords or extension cords
	✓ For food, air fresheners, shaving cream, deodorant, hairspray, etc. <i>Empty cans. Remove caps and place loose in recycling container.</i>	✗ No spray paint cans ✗ No aerosol cans with any contents remaining ✗ No propane cylinders or bottles
	✓ For frozen juice concentrate, potato chips, cookie dough, coffee, nuts, baby formula, etc. <i>Remove lids and place loose in recycling container.</i>	
	✓ For food, e.g., seafood, cat food, etc. <i>Empty and rinse cans. Labels OK. Remove lids, drop into can and squeeze top slightly.</i>	✗ No deposit cans (take deposit containers to Return-It Depot for deposit refund)
	✓ Foil wrap and take-out containers such as pie plates, food trays, etc. <i>Empty containers.</i>	✗ No chip or foil bags ✗ No foil wrap with paper backing for butter, cigarettes, etc. ✗ No foil-lined cardboard take-out containers or lids
	✓ For milk, milk-type beverages, cream, soup, broth, sauces, etc.	✗ No juice/drink boxes (take deposit containers to Return-It Depot for deposit refund) ✗ No straws ✗ No stand up pouches
	✓ For ice cream, frozen yogurt, etc.	
	✓ For milk, milk-type beverages, cream, substitute eggs, sugar, molasses, etc. <i>Gable-top cartons may have plastic screw tops. Empty and rinse cartons. Remove caps and place loose in recycling container.</i>	✗ No juice cartons (take deposit containers to Return-It Depot for deposit refund)

Blue Box for Container Recycling - continued

Material	Description	Not Accepted
	✓ For soups and entrees <i>Remove lids and place loose in recycling container.</i>	✗ No bowls with metal rims ✗ No paper napkins
	✓ For hot and cold beverages. <i>Empty and rinse cups.</i>	✗ No straws or non-paper insulating wraps ✗ No foam cups
	✓ For food, dish soap, mouthwash, shampoos, conditioners and other personal care products, pills and vitamins, household cleaners, automotive cleaners, e.g., glass cleaner, windshield washer fluid, laundry products, etc. <i>Plastic bottles with screw caps or spray, pump or pull-up tops. Empty and rinse bottles. Labels OK. Remove caps, spray pump and pull-up tops, and place loose in recycling container.</i>	✗ No beverage bottles (take deposit containers to Return-It Depot for deposit refund) ✗ No stand up pouches ✗ No containers for motor oil, vehicle lubricant, or antifreeze products
	✓ For milk, cooking oil, laundry detergent and fabric softener, cleaning solutions, cleaning products, body care products, windshield washer fluid, etc. <i>Empty and rinse jugs. Labels OK. Remove caps and place loose in recycling container. Flatten to save room.</i>	✗ No jugs for flavoured tea, juice or other deposit beverage containers (take to Return-It Depot for deposit refund)
	✓ For peanut butter, jam, nuts, condiments, vitamins and supplements, personal care products and cosmetics, pharmaceuticals, etc. <i>Plastic jars have wide mouths with screw-top lids. Empty and rinse jars. Labels OK. Remove lids and place loose in recycling container.</i>	
	✓ For baked goods, fruit, produce, eggs, etc. <i>Containers are clear with hinged or click-closed tops. Labels OK. Empty and rinse containers.</i>	✗ No packaging labelled biodegradable or compostable
	✓ For deli chicken, single serve meals, prepared foods, baked goods, housewares and hardware, e.g. screws, picture hangers, etc. <i>Containers are clear or have black bottom trays with clear domes. Empty and rinse trays.</i> ✓ Rigid plastic packaging for toys, toothbrushes, batteries, etc. Remove paper backing and recycle paper separately in yellow bag.	✗ No foam ✗ No liquid-absorbing pads ✗ No plastic wrap for meat, poultry, fish or cheese ✗ No blister packaging, e.g., protective packaging for items like chewing gum or pills
	✓ For products such as margarine, spreads, dairy products such as yogurt, cottage cheese, sour cream, ice cream, etc. <i>Empty and rinse tubs. Remove lids and place loose in recycling container.</i> <i>For single use coffee and tea pods: Empty and rinse pods. Remove lids and do not include lids with recycling.</i>	✗ No plastic wrap ✗ No packaging labelled biodegradable or compostable ✗ No plastic or foil lids from coffee and tea pods
	✓ Beverage take out cups <i>Empty and rinse cups. Remove lids and place loose in recycling container.</i>	✗ No foam cups ✗ No packaging labelled biodegradable or compostable ✗ No paper napkins
	✓ For bedding plants, seedlings, vegetable plants, etc. <i>Remove residue from garden pots and trays.</i>	✗ No ceramic plant pots ✗ No lawn edging, tarps, plastic furniture or toys ✗ No garden hoses ✗ No plastic string or rope ✗ No residue in garden pots
	✓ For laundry detergent, ice cream, pet food, etc. <i>Container size is less than 25L.</i>	✗ No plastic paint cans ✗ No plastic pails larger than 25L ✗ No pails for lubricants and oils




Red Box for Non-Deposit Glass Bottles & Jars Recycling

Material	Description	Not Accepted
	✓ Clear or coloured <i>Empty and rinse bottles and jars. Recycle lid. Labels OK.</i> <i>No deposit glass bottles (take deposit containers to Return-It Depot for deposit refund)</i>	✗ No drinking glasses, dishes, cookware, whole or broken glass or mirrors ✗ No ceramic products ✗ No light bulbs and fixtures

The following items are not collected curbside.

These items can be brought to a Recycle BC depot for recycling.

	Plastic bags for groceries and dry cleaning; bags for bread, newspapers and flyers; pre-washed salad bags; bags for produce and dry bulk foods; frozen vegetable bags; outer wrap for soft drink can flats; water softener salt, wood pellet and garden product bags; outer bags for diaper and feminine hygiene products; overwrap on mattresses, furniture and electronic equipment	✗ No crinkly cellophane wrap, e.g., for tea, floral arrangements ✗ No kitchen stretch wrap or plastic wrap for meat, poultry, fish or cheese, zipper-lock bags, no plastic net bags for onions ✗ No plastic shipping envelopes, bubble packaging ✗ No plastic bags labelled biodegradable or compostable ✗ No multi-layer, laminated plastic packaging, e.g. for bacon, deli meats, cheese slices, etc. No potato chip or snack bags ✗ No lumber or construction wrap ✗ No garbage bags (all colours)
	Clean meat trays; foam egg cartons; foam clamshells, cups and bowls for take-out food, etc.	✗ No liquid-absorbing pads used in trays for meat ✗ No shrink wrap for meat, poultry, fish, cheese, etc. ✗ No paper napkins
	To protect electronics, small appliances, etc.	✗ No foam peanuts, packing chips or noodles ✗ No blue or pink foam board insulation ✗ No labels, tape, paper and cardboard on foam packaging
