The White Rock Museum & Archives would like to invite you to join us for *Canada Day by the Bay*, the City of White Rock's annual July 1<sup>st</sup> celebration held along the waterfront. There will be live entertainment, kid's activities, and vendors lining the promenade, with a grand finale of fireworks at dusk.

This year the White Rock Museum & Archives will be organizing the vendors, local artisans and businesses, who wish to promote, showcase, and sell their work. The focus will be on vendors that make, bake and grow. All proceeds go towards supporting children's programs at the Museum.

Each vendor is allocated a space that can accommodate a 10x10 pop up tent. **All tents must be weighted down with 30 pounds of weight on each leg for safety.** Allocations of space are assigned based on vendor type and at the discretion of the coordinators. No vendor is guaranteed a specific space. All vendors are required to provide their own tent, table, and chairs. You may share your booth space with another vendor, however, full payment from one of you is required and you must note the additional vendor on your application. Please note: there is **NO** access to power.

Completion and submission of your application is required to participate. Once the Museum has reviewed and accepted your application, we ask that you please submit your **payment in full** via credit card (accepted by phone), cheque, or cash to:

**Please note:** Pay parking is in effect between 10AM and 12 Midnight. All vendors are responsible for parking fees. West Beach set up time is 8am; take down time is 4pm.

***Non-allowable items:***

Please no alcohol, tobacco, drug products or paraphernalia. Our focus is on make, bake and grow, we encourage you to limit any imported items in the creation of your merchandise.

***Cancellation Policy:***

Please note that there is a \$50.00 cancellation fee, and no cancellations will be accepted after May 8<sup>th</sup>. No space will be reserved until a vendors application has been approved and paid in full.

***Waiver, Release, and Assumption of Risk***

I understand and acknowledge the risks of participating in *Canada Day by the Bay* as a vendor, including, but not limited to the risk of theft or damage to my merchandise, and accept full responsibility and agree to participate at my own risk.

I hereby waive any and all claims that I may now and in the future have against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue the City of White Rock, the White Rock Museum & Archives, and their respective agents, officers, employees, volunteers or representatives (all together, the "Releases") for any loss, damage, personal or bodily injury, death sustained or suffered by me as a result of my participation in the *Canada Day by the Bay* event due to any cause whatsoever, including without limitation, negligence, foul or breach of statutory duty, including duties arising from the Occupiers Liability Act.

In no event will the Releases be liable for any loss, damage, personal or bodily injury or death nor for any loss of or damage (including indirect or consequential damages) that I suffer whether attributable to or arising out of my participation in *Canada Day by the Bay* or by reason of any matter or thing done or permitted.
