Access to the City's legal advice correspondence is unavailable. Legal advice correspondence is exempted from the disclosure requirements of the Act pursuant to Section 14 and privilege at common law.

Access to the remaining records is available. However, some of the information in the records is excepted from the disclosure requirements of the Act. I have severed the excepted information so that I could disclose to you the remaining information as attached.

The severed information is excepted from disclosure under Sections 12(3)(b), 14, and 22 of the Act. Severing under Section 12(3)(b)is necessary to protect the substance of closed meeting deliberations of Council that have not otherwise been disclosed or authorized for disclosure. Severing under Section 14 is necessary to protect information that is subject to legal privilege. Finally, severing under Section 22 is necessary to avoid disclosing any third-party personal information without permission.

David Chesney's Censure - Timeline

May 06, 2019

Shorrtly after I was elected Mayor Bbaldiwn called me into his office and very sternly informed me I had to shut down The White Rock Sun. I explained to him that was not going to happen. The conversation very quickly deteriorated and I stood up and told the mayor I did not care for where the conversation was going. I stood up to leave and he began yelling "I am going to be watching you, I will get you!"

Within a couple of months DON PITCAIRN a columnist for the White Rock Sun in an editorial said "When I heard councillor GRANT MEYER had stated at an open meeting he wanted to clear cut the hump, he was surprised in that MEYER was the rep for the BNSF. Pitcairn said **Redacted S. 22** 

" That was all Baldwin needed. He pulled out the guns an informed me he was going to move with censuring me. I consulted with a laweyer in Vancouver who specializes in civic politics. He sent a letter to the city stating he felt the city was in no position to censure me.

The day of the censurship downstairs in a IN CAMERA meeting it was decided by council (with the excepiton of Heln Fathers) voted to proceed with the censurship. OF course for the majority of the discussion I was out of the room.

As we went upstairs Helen explained the point of contention was council felt Pitcairn had labelled **Redacted S. 22**. Not the case. When we got upstairs into the council chambers I asked Mayor Baldwin if we could talk in private. We recessed into his office and I asked him how =we could avoid this distraction so early in the council's mandate. He said wait here and I will talk to CAO Bottrill. He came back in and said the censurhip would be suspended if I did the following.

- 1. apologize fo councillor Meyer
- 2. Remove the offensive refverence
- 3. Publish an apology the following week when the next Pitcairn editorial ran. I agreed to all three points.

At the conclusion of the council meeting everyone wondered what the hell happened in that the censurhip was not brough forward. Following the conclusion of the meeting I stood up and walked over to councillor Meyer and said I would like to speak to him in private. Councilor Fathers grabbed me by the arm and said "what the hll happened?"

I said I will tell you later right now I need to privately speak with councillor Meyer. We stepped behind the glass door for privacy purposes and I apologized to councillor Meyer. He accepted my apology and we shook hands. All of this was witnessed by councillor Fathers.

I then wen t home and removed the **s. 22** reference. I then sent an email to Meyer/Bottrill and Baldwin explainging I had fulfilled two of the three directives. In that I wanted to ensure we had the proper wording for the aplogy I informed Merye/Battirill and Baldwin that I would like them to decide on the wording of the apology. I waited a full week, when the following Monday came around I informed mayor Baldwin I had not published an apology due to the fact I had not received the wording from them, but I was still willing to fulfill the request. Mayor Baldwin then infom=rmed me councillor Meyer did not accept mhy apology. Huh?

The mayor then said as a result of Meyer claimging he did not accept my apology they would be proceeding with my censurship.

It was interesting to note a few months later Meyer in a closed meeting asked Lidstone **Redacted S. 12(3)(b), s. 14** 

He pressed Lidstone what could we do. Lidstone stated "
Redacted S. 12(3)(b), s. 14

I fully take advantage of the second censure. I would do it again given the same circumstances. I had sat and listened for months **Redacted S. 22** 

Due to my fist censure which I believe was totall BS the severity of my second censure was far too serious in my humble opinion.

Vancouver and Langley recently censured members of council and it was a simple IN CAMERA dressing down with no financial or privledge suspension.

For this reason I would like the new council to review what was done to me under the previous council.


