E1 was dispatched for an assist with flooding. Upon arrival E1 crew met s. 22 the resident in the front yard where he was investigating where the main water shut off was. E1 crew entered through the front door and could hear water flowing in the downstairs of the home. The investigation determined that the water was coming from the main domestic service entering the home in the mechanical room. CA Smith removed a small portion of the drywall to find considerable water (assuming city pressure) was flowing through what appeared to be a broken coupling. FF Meneghin remained in the front yard with s. 22 and was successful in shutting off the city water supply line. The entire basement floor had approx 1" of water. E1 crew determined that the flooding was so substantial that efforts to begin to remove some of the water would be futile. We discussed with s. 22 our findings and how we would not be able to assist in any cleanup due to the volume of water and damage already sustained. He was instructed to contact his insurance carrier and his builder.
