Re: Request for Records
Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act

The City of White Rock has reviewed your request for access to the following information pursuant to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act"):

- *the total amounts the City received per year (2016, 2017, 2018) for mooring fees from the Yacht club or private individuals for the wharf on the west side of the pier*
- *any fees being received for the mooring on the east side of the pier*
- *the insurance premium for the west side wharf*
- *Also, how much has been spent on consultants regarding the west side wharf and any wharf expansion plans?*

Access to this information is available. The City did not receive any amounts directly for moorage at the west wharf. The White Rock Harbour Board managed the moorage arrangements pursuant to its contract with the City.

There is no moorage associated with the east side of the Pier.

The insurance premium for the entire Pier, including property and marine liability coverage, was about \$13K in 2016, 2017, and 2018. The White Rock Harbour Board reimbursed the City for the marine liability portion, paying \$4,500 for 2016 and \$5,600 for both 2017 and 2018.

The City paid \$16K to Westmar Advisors and SNC Lavalin in 2019. There are no consulting payments to date for 2020, but Westmar has work in progress at an estimated cost of \$29.6K.
