Alarms indicated 4th floor sprinkler. No indication of a sprinkler activation was visible on the 4th floor. When we went to the garage there was water coming through the ceiling. Had a crew go to the 4th floor to isolate the 4th floor sprinkler. When they could not locate the isolation valve the sprinkler was shut off in the mechanical room. We gained access to suite 405 and found where the sprinkler pipe was broken. There had been a significant amount of water that had flowed through the pipe and the water had gone through all the suites below it. Redacted S. 22, strata council treasurer, had notified Fraser valley fire protection as well as the restoration company. Advised Redacted S. 22 that a fire watch had to be in place until the sprinklers were fixed and the system was reset. Fraser valley was on scene while we were still there. Told him the actions that we had taken and then we cleared.
