- I am requesting records for the period August 15, 2019 through December 31, 2019
- Meeting notes from a meeting held at the White Rock Museum held in early September to discuss the project that was eventually named Jingle Bell Rock and a second meeting held in early October at the White Rock Museum on the same topic. In addition, I am requesting notes related to two meetings at City Hall hosted by Mayor Walker to discuss the planning of the Jingle Bell Rock event.

### Winter at the Waterfront Draft Meeting Notes - October 17, 2019

In attendance: Mayor Walker, Alex Nixon, Executive Director, BIA, Ritu Khanna, Executive Director, WRSS Chamber of Commerce, Redacted S. 22, Chair, Waterfront Development Task Force, S.22, White Rock Festival of Lights Society

### **Background**

There are two winter initiatives working in tandem:

- 1. The White Rock Festival of the Lights Society (WRFL) wish to beautify and light up the waterfront from December 6 to January 6, and,
- 2. The BIA and the WRSS Chamber and other community businesses and organizations wish to create a Christmas/winter themed special event on December 7.

Mayor Walker stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss synergies resulting in:

- A lit up waterfront area during the dark winter season
- Enthusiasm from the businesses to participate in winter initiatives
- More people visiting White Rock during the off season

### White Rock Festival of Lights - December 6, 2019 to January 6, 2020

This initiative, led by the WRFL Society, is working directly with the Engineering & Municipal Operations. Out of scope is a special event. In scope are the following details, being followed up on by Jim Gordon:

- Christmas themed lighting starting on December 7th on the Pier
- RGB lights on the museum before December 7th
- Six foot tall fir trees in buckets on the concrete amphitheater seating and around Memorial Park.
- Power on the median with trees in East Beach, west of Finlay and in front of the "Sea Shell Store" so they can be lit.
- Ideas for more affordable insurance for the WRFL Society's initiative
- Monitoring, as needed, with \$22 of Crescent electrical for a permit and plugging in lights.

### A Saturday Dec 7 Special Event during the White Rock Festival of Lights

While the Festival of Lights is a multi-day winter lights initiative, the desire to create a one-day special event in December at the waterfront was raised by the BIA and the WRSS Chamber of commerce.

The WRSS Chamber of Commerce has no budget or organizing team. They will provide in-kind marketing assistance and send a representative to the community committee.

The BIA will confirm that it has the capacity to partner with the City's special event team to plan, coordinate and execute a special event on December 7 as a " $\underline{B}$ " level event.

Once BIA partnership is confirmed, the event is envisioned for December 7 from 1:30-5:30, followed by the International Yacht Club's Sail Past 5:30-6:30. Activities could include:

- A large tent with clear walls on Memorial plaza, lit with small roof lights creating a snow globe effect
- A riser inside for choirs and other entertainers
- Ice sculptures outdoors on the plaza
- The Museum Christmas Craft Fair
- Dickens style carolers
- Visit from Santa, Letters to Santa

#### Next Steps

White Rock Festival of Lights: Jim Gordon and Redacted S. 22 will continue to meet to plan and confirm details of the lighting initiative

Dec 7 Special Event – Working name: "Jingle Bell Rock" at the White Rock Festival of Lights: If the special events team confirm BIA partnership as a "B" level event, the next programming and logistics meeting will take place October 29 with Courtney, Elizabeth and BIA programming team. If partnership is not secured, the City will have to decide whether to take the event on as an "A" level, or not hold an event.


As we close out the year, I just want to say what an honour it has been to serve in this role for a little more than year. I remember Cliff Annable quite

# Background

There are two winter initiatives working in tandem:

- 1. The White Rock Festival of the Lights Society (WRFL) wish to beautify and light up the waterfront from December 6 to January 6, and,
- 2. The WRSS Chamber and other community businesses and organizations wish to create a Christmas/winter themed special event on December 7.

Mayor Walker stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss synergies resulting in:

- A lit up waterfront area during the dark winter season
- Enthusiasm from the businesses to participate in winter initiatives
- More people visiting White Rock during the off season

# White Rock Festival of Lights – December 6, 2019 to January 6, 2020

This initiative, led by the WRFL Society, is working directly with the Engineering & Municipal Operations. Out of scope is a special event. In scope are the following details, being followed up on by Jim Gordon:

- Christmas themed lighting starting on December 7<sup>th</sup> on the Pier
- RGB lights on the museum before December 7<sup>th</sup>
- Six foot tall fir trees in buckets on the concrete amphitheater seating and around Memorial Park.
- Power on the median with trees in East Beach, west of Finlay and in front of the "Sea Shell Store" so they can be lit.
- Ideas for more affordable insurance for the WRFL Society's initiative
- Monitoring, as needed, with 222 of Crescent electrical for a permit and plugging in lights.

# A Special Event during the White Rock Festival of Lights

While the Festival of Lights is a multi-day winter lights initiative, the desire to create a one-day special event in December at the waterfront was raised by the BIA and the WRSS Chamber of commerce.

The WRSS Chamber of Commerce has no budget or organizing team. They will provide in-kind marketing assistance and send a representative to the community committee.

The BIA will confirm that it has the capacity to partner with the City's special event team to plan, coordinate and execute a special event on December 7 as a "B" level event.

Once BIA partnership is confirmed, the event is envisioned for December 7 from 1:30-5:30 followed by the International Yacht Club's Sail Past. Activities could include:

- A large tent with clear walls on Memorial plaza, lit with small roof lights creating a snow globe effect
- A riser inside for choirs and other entertainers
- Ice sculptures outdoors on the plaza
- The Museum Christmas Craft Fair
- Dickens style Carollers
