S1 arrived on scene and found one vehicle had crashed into the concrete medical building at this location. The driver had already left and walked to PAH hospital for some possible stitches to s. 22 hand from the incident. Redacted S. 22 remained on scene and witnessed the accident and relayed all the information to us. There was no structural damage to the building and a tow was required for the vehicle. Scene was safe and Rcmp remained at the incident until a tow truck could remove the vehicle. E1 then cleared.

No medical information could be taken.
